
Shopping center A Bloc is the beating heart and meeting place of the Aalto University Otaniemi campus with its restaurants, cafés and other services.


A Bloc was constructed in 2018 in connection with the Aalto University metro station, and houses restaurants and cafés, sports services, specialty stores, grocery stores, a pharmacy and Alko. The shopping center also has a 12 sam pop-up space and a promotional spot for lease. A Bloc is a part of the building complex designed by Verstas Architects, which also includes the School of Arts, Design and Architecture and the School of Business.


A Bloc is located in Espoo right in the center of Otaniemi with excellent public transport connections. The other entrance of the Aalto University metro station is located within the shopping center. Otaniemi bus lines run next to the building and also Jokeri Light Rail pass the shopping center.

Approximately 17 000 customers visit A Bloc daily during the week, and approximately 7 000 during the weekend. The shopping center is owned by Aalto University Foundation sr and managed by and managed by Aalto University Properties Ltd.


